Visit to Okhla Bird Sanctuary



A Nature Camp was organized by ECO CLUB of Dronacharya Group of Institutions, Greater Noida on 10th February, 2015 at Okhla Bird Sanctuary, Noida. Dr. Neeraj Bala and Dr. S. K. Srivastava, Department of Applied Sciences and Humanities, along with 51 first year students visited the Okhla Bird **Sanctuary**. The visit aimed to make the students aware with the diversity of wildlife. **Okhla Bird Sanctuary** is about roughly 4 square Kilometers in size and situated at the entrance of Noida in *Gautam Buddha Nagar* district of Uttar Pradesh. There are more than 188 plants species and 320 bird species recorded here. Out of these, there were 20 common resident water bird species, 44 common resident woodland species and 43 migratory water birds. This predominately wetland reserve (established in 1990) is an important Bird Area (IBA), managed by the Forest Department. The sanctuary seems to be popular with joggers and photographers.
