13. Candidates who are short-listed on the basis of CET will be called for Personality Test at one of the Air Force Selection Boards (AFSBs) situated at Dehradun, Mysore & Varanasi. Testing at AFSBs consists of two Stages: Stage I Test, consisting of Intelligence Test and Picture Perception and Discussion Test (PP&DT), will be conducted on the first day. Stage I test is a screening test and only those who qualify would undergo Stage II testing. Others would be sent back on the first day itself. Stage II tests consisting o Psychological Test, Group Test and Interview will be conducted on the subsequent days (four days). 14. Medical Examination will be conducted at AFCME, New Delhi or IAM, Bengaluru for those who are recommended by AFSBs

after stage-II testing. 15. Candidates recommended by the AFSBs and declared medically fit will be detailed for training in order of All India Merit Lis depending on the number of vacancies available.
